FROM THE PRIEST

I remember a Sister from 3rd grade catechesis class telling us to know the number 613...Why the number 613? Because there were 613 precepts of the Old Testament that the Pharisees had to know, along with ritual practices!

All of us in the class could not believe the Pharisees knew that many precepts (the Ten Commandments and Beatitudes were hard enough) and the Pharisees always challenged those who claimed to know God's law.

And of course, they tested Jesus to see if He knew the law as they did. But Jesus comes and offers a simple response with a deep knowledge of God's law:

The Lord our God is Lord alone!
You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart,
with all your soul,
with all your mind,
and with all your strength.
The second is this:
You shall love your neighbor as yourself.

What God needs from all of us is love – to love as God loves! God is love and everything that He does comes from His love for us. He loves us first and foremost, and our love for Him is a thankful response for all that He's done for us. The more we understand His love and truth, the more we love what God loves.

The way we can understand and grow God's love and truth in each one of us is to have Faith in Him, and hope in what He promises us with the help of the Holy Spirit. The more we know God, the more we can love Him, and the more we love Him with the help of the Holy Spirit, we can further believe and hope in what He promises us.

May we love as God loves with the gift of the Holy Spirit, and understand that love is a sacrificial love that we must continue to share with others!

DEL SACERDOTE

Recuerdo que la hermana de la clase de catequesis de tercer grado nos decía que conociéramos el número 613... ¿Por qué el número 613? ¿Porque había 613 preceptos del Antiguo Testamento que los fariseos tenían que saber, junto con las prácticas rituales!

Todos en la clase no podíamos creer que los fariseos supieran tantos preceptos (los Diez Mandamientos y las Bienaventuranzas eran bastante difíciles) y los fariseos siempre desafiaban a quienes decían conocer la ley de Dios.

Y por supuesto, pusieron a prueba a Jesús para ver si conocía la ley como ellos. Pero Jesús viene y ofrece una respuesta sencilla con un profundo conocimiento de la ley de Dios:

*¡El Señor nuestro Dios es Señor solamente!
Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón,
con toda tu alma,
con toda tu mente,
y con todas tus fuerzas.
El segundo es este:
Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo.*

Lo que Dios necesita de todos nosotros es amor: ¡amar como Dios ama! Dios es amor y todo lo que hace proviene de su amor por nosotros. Él nos ama en primer lugar y por sobre todas las cosas, y nuestro amor por Él es una respuesta de agradecimiento por todo lo que Él ha hecho por nosotros. Cuanto más entendemos Su amor y Su verdad, más amamos lo que Dios ama.

La manera en que podemos entender y hacer crecer el amor y la verdad de Dios en cada uno de nosotros es tener Fe en Él y esperar en lo que Él nos promete con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo. Cuanto más conocemos a Dios, más podemos amarlo, y cuanto más lo amamos con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, más podemos creer y esperar en lo que Él nos promete.

¡Que amemos como Dios ama con el don del Espíritu Santo y entendamos que el amor es un amor sacrificial que debemos seguir compartiendo con los demás!

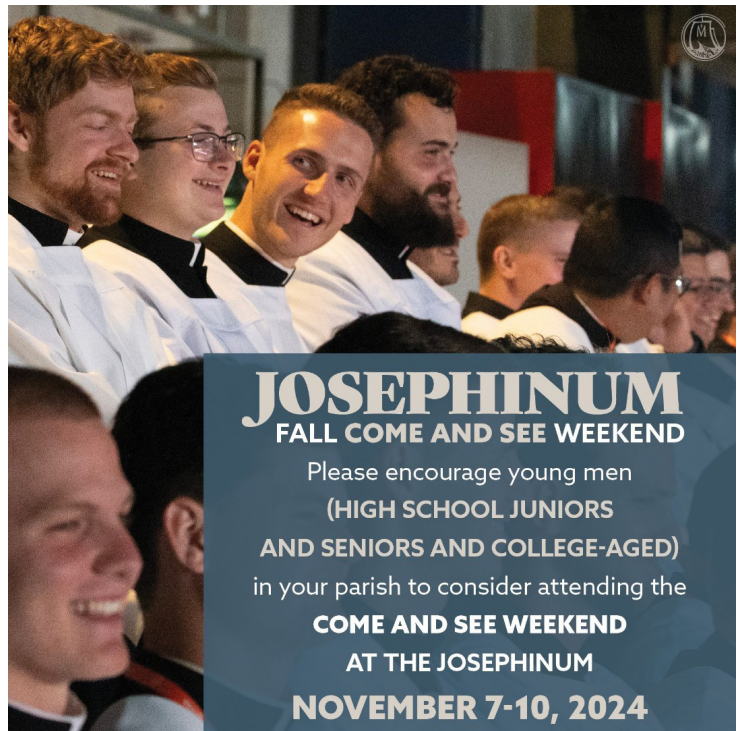

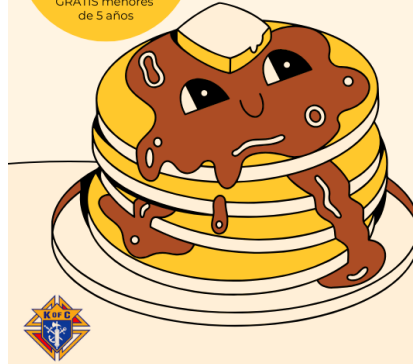

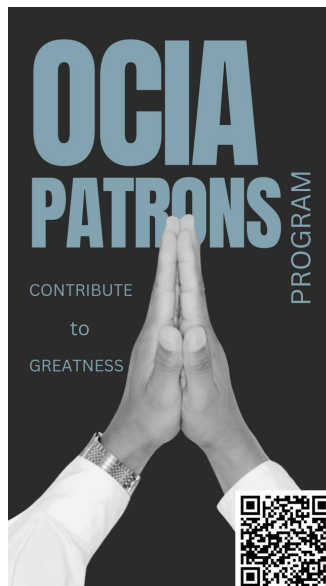
