This weekend, we celebrate the 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time. The first reading from the prophet Zephaniah provides us with detailed instructions, or actions, we need to take in our relationship with the Lord. First, we must seek. What must we seek? We need to seek justice and humility. Why do we need to seek justice and humility? Because through our own faults we lack those qualities often and must work to achieve them.

How do we become humble and just? By following the Lord's example first and taking refuge in Him. When we serve others, we grow in humility, when we serve others, we become more just as followers of Christ. To seek and to serve are both actions that go hand in hand. When we seek, we search and hopefully remain persistent until we find that which we are seeking. Our faith is a call to action by following Jesus and serving others. Humility is the key that unlocks for us the doors to justice. By following the prophet Zephaniah's instructions, we take refuge in the Lord and become humble and just with others in the world around us.

In chapter 5 of the Gospel of Matthew today, Jesus teaches and gifts us the Beatitudes. These are His promises to us in eternal life to come for persevering in this life. Jesus knows our troubles and promises us that we are never alone, that He is with us always, offering His grace, love and mercy to sustain us. We can rejoice and be glad and have hope despite life's challenges, because our reward will be great in heaven.

This past week we had quite a snowstorm, followed by extreme cold. Please consider leaving donations in the back of the church. We are focusing this month on batteries (AA, AAA, D, 9-volt) and propane canisters for our homeless. Tom Rock will pick these items up and distribute to those in need. Thank you for your assistance.

Jesús conoce nuestras dificultades y nos promete que nunca estamos solos, que Él está siempre con nosotros, ofreciéndonos su gracia, amor y misericordia para sostenernos. 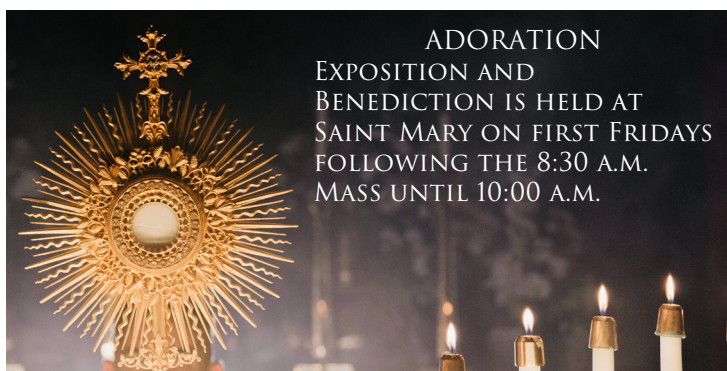

FULLY ENGAGED MENTOR COUPLES

St. Mary's uses the program *Fully Engaged* to prepare engaged couples for the Sacrament of Marriage. Around 40 couples complete their marriage preparation at St. Mary's each year. *Fully Engaged* utilizes mentor couples to work through the material of the program with these engaged couples. We are looking for married couples to join our team of trained *Fully Engaged* mentors!

Requirements: We are looking for couples who have been married at least five years and are practicing Catholics. Mentor couples should be interested in facilitating important conversations between couples, promoting the use of Natural Family Planning (NFP), inviting couples to have a chaste engagement, helping couples learn more about the Catholic faith and Church teachings, and offering guidance and support as couples prepare for this lifelong vocation.

Training: Each new mentor couple must complete a training led by the Diocese or the Wedding Preparation Coordinator at St. Mary's.

Time Commitment: Mentors lead 4-5 meetings with the engaged couple which are spaced out about once per month. Mentors meet with 1-2 couples per year.


