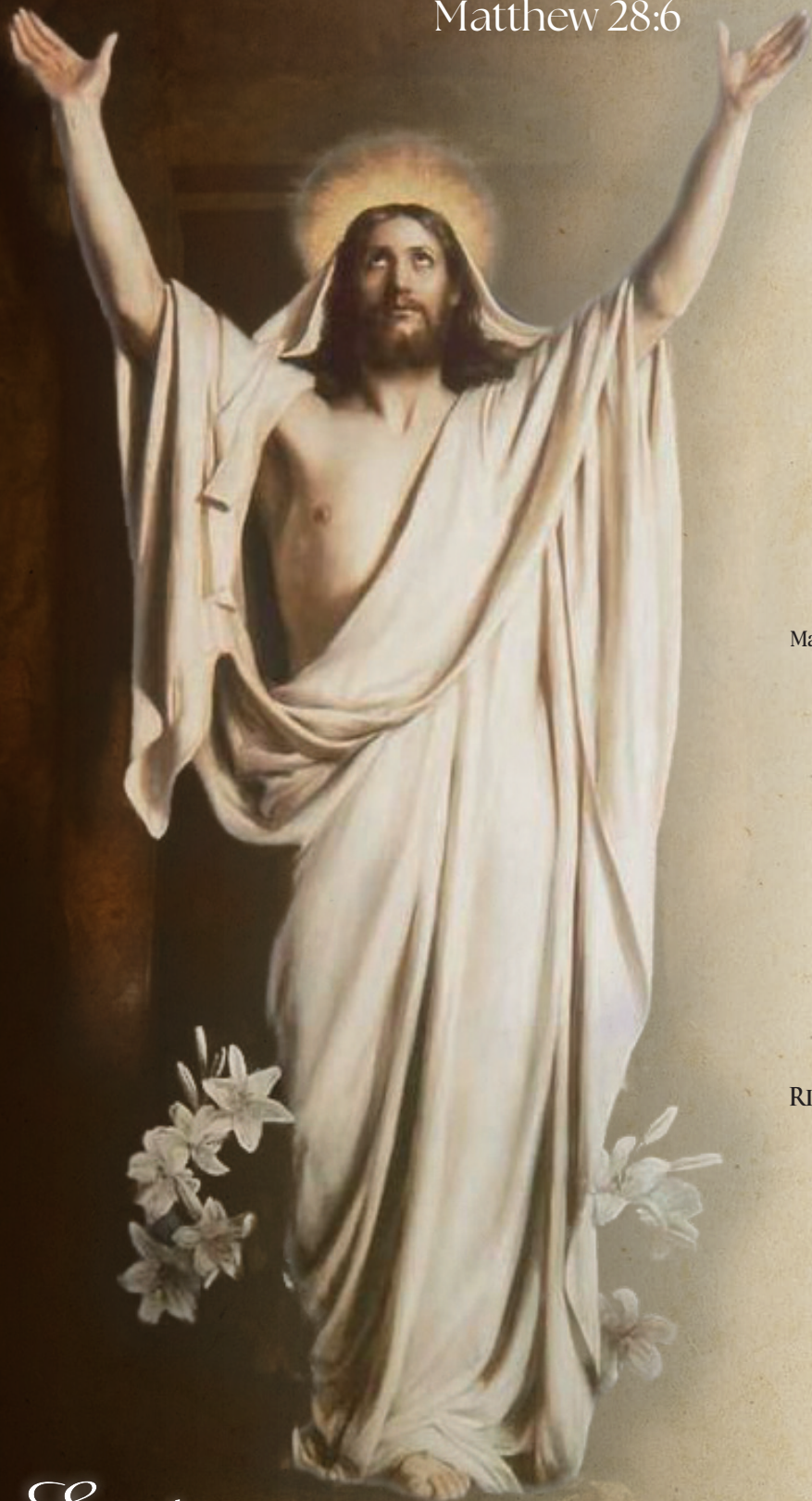

FROM THE PRIEST

On behalf of St. Mary's staff and myself, Happy Easter, Alleluia! Christ is Risen! This Sunday, we celebrate the glory of God. By virtue of our Baptism, we share in Christ's Resurrection over sin and death.

A big congratulations and welcome to the 48 catechumens and candidates that came into the Catholic Church at St. Mary's, and across the diocese, and the world at last night's Easter Vigil. It was a night to remember as we celebrated Christ's conquering of sin and death through His great suffering, sacrifice and glorious Resurrection. The statues were unveiled, the "Gloria" was sung for the first time since Lent started, and the "Alleluia" was chanted before the Gospel.

The Responsorial Psalm refrain today says, "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." We can all reflect on the beautiful gift Easter is for all of us. Every day is the day the Lord has made, and we are to rejoice and be glad. Every day is a gift, and today we reflect on the greatest gift God the Father ever gave us in His Son, our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Our hearts are overwhelmed with gratitude that Christ came and conquered death and sin on the Cross, and by His Resurrection opened for us the gates of Heaven.

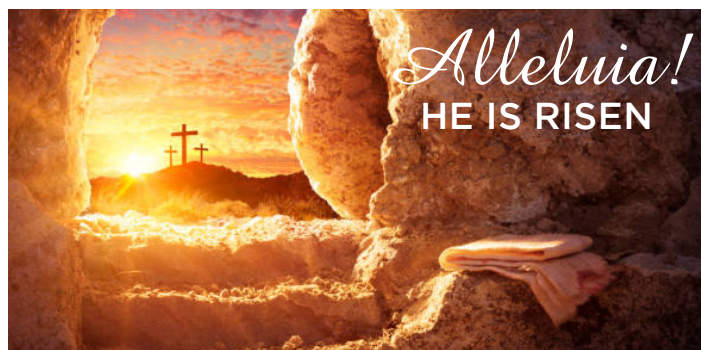
In the Gospel today, we see that it was a woman and close friend and follower of Jesus, Mary of Magdala, who went to the tomb first and discovered that the large rock had been removed. Scripture said she "ran" to tell Peter and John, and that they too went "running" to see. John was younger and got there first, but we notice he waited until Peter got there to inspect the tomb first. This points to the primacy of Peter, as Our Lord chose him as His first successor. This Apostolic succession can be traced from Peter, 2000 years later to Pope Leo.

Just as Jesus chose Peter, He chooses us to follow Him! May we always choose Him and seek His infinite love.

Yesterday, we had a great time at the Easter Egg Hunt, thank-you to all who participated. A very special thank-you to all of you for attending Easter Mass and for all who attended the Triduum. Most especially, thank you to everyone who volunteered, decorated and worked behind the scenes to make our Easter Liturgies holy and beautiful. Thank you to the choir for all the hard work they put in, as the music and singing added to the beauty of the Masses. Now, let's celebrate the Glory of God!

DEL SACERDOTE

En nombre del personal de St. Mary's y en el mío propio: ¡Felices Pascuas, aleluya! ¡Cristo ha resucitado! Este domingo celebramos la gloria de Dios. En virtud de nuestro Bautismo, compartimos la resurrección de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte.

Una gran felicitación y una cálida bienvenida a los 48 catecúmenos y candidatos que ingresaron en la Iglesia Católica —tanto en St. Mary's como en toda la diócesis y el mundo— durante la Vigilia Pascual de anoche. Fue una noche memorable, en la que celebramos la victoria de Cristo sobre el pecado y la muerte a través de su gran sufrimiento, su sacrificio y su gloriosa resurrección. Se descubrieron las imágenes, se cantó el "Gloria" por primera vez desde el inicio de la Cuaresma y se entonó el "Aleluya" antes del Evangelio.

El estribillo del salmo responsorial de hoy dice: "Este es el día que hizo el Señor; regocijémonos y alegrémonos". Todos podemos reflexionar sobre el hermoso regalo que la Pascua representa para nosotros. Cada día es el día que hizo el Señor, y debemos regocijarnos y alegrarnos. Cada día es un regalo, y hoy reflexionamos sobre el mayor regalo que Dios Padre nos ha dado jamás en su Hijo, nuestro Señor y Salvador, Jesucristo. Nuestros corazones rebosan de gratitud porque Cristo vino y venció a la muerte y al pecado en la Cruz, y, mediante su resurrección, nos abrió las puertas del Cielo.

En el Evangelio de hoy vemos que fue una mujer —amiga cercana y seguidora de Jesús, María Magdalena— quien acudió primero al sepulcro y descubrió que la gran piedra había sido removida. Las Escrituras relatan que ella corrió para avisar a Pedro y a Juan, y que ellos también fueron corriendo a comprobarlo. Juan, al ser más joven, llegó primero; sin embargo, observamos que esperó a que llegara Pedro para que fuera este quien inspeccionara el sepulcro en primer lugar. Esto apunta a la primacía de Pedro, pues Nuestro Señor lo eligió como su primer sucesor. Esta sucesión apostólica puede rastrearse desde Pedro y, a lo largo de dos mil años, hasta el Papa León.

¡Así como Jesús eligió a Pedro, nos elige también a nosotros para seguirlo! Que sepamos elegirlo siempre y buscar su amor infinito.

Ayer lo pasamos de maravilla en la búsqueda de huevos de Pascua; gracias a todos los que participaron. Un agradecimiento muy especial a todos ustedes por asistir a la Misa de Pascua y a todos los que participaron en el Triduo. Muy especialmente, gracias a todos los que se ofrecieron como voluntarios, decoraron y trabajaron tras bastidores para hacer que nuestras liturgias de Pascua fueran santas y hermosas. Gracias al coro por todo el arduo trabajo que realizaron, ya que la música y el canto realzaron la belleza de las Misas. ¡Ahora celebremos la Gloria de Dios!

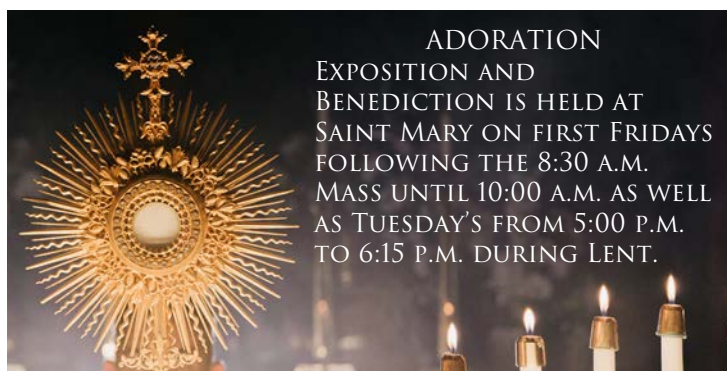

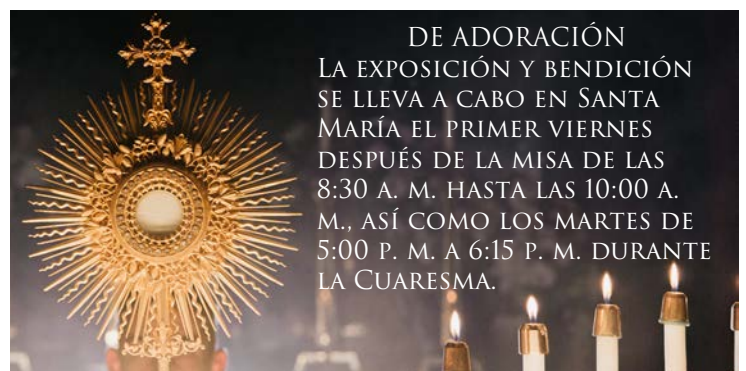

Knowing well the end of the story, it is difficult for us to imagine how it all unfolded for Mary Magdalene and Jesus' disciples as they were living it when it all happened. How does hope persist through the devastating grief of mourning a dear friend? How does love prevail over the heart-breaking trauma of witnessing such a gruesome and violent death? How do you interpret the stone which has been rolled away, the empty tomb, the burial clothes folded up?

Easter faith – placing our trust and joy in the Resurrection – invites us to embrace God's gift of hope and perseverance through every human trial and during our worst moments. Whatever life looks like in the moment, whatever darkness we pass through, whatever stone seems immovable, in every moment of death – God's love and mercy cannot be held back. When the power of the Resurrection grasps us, new possibilities of love, understanding and compassion are within reach.

FE PASCUAL*Reflexión sobre Juan 20, 1-9*
