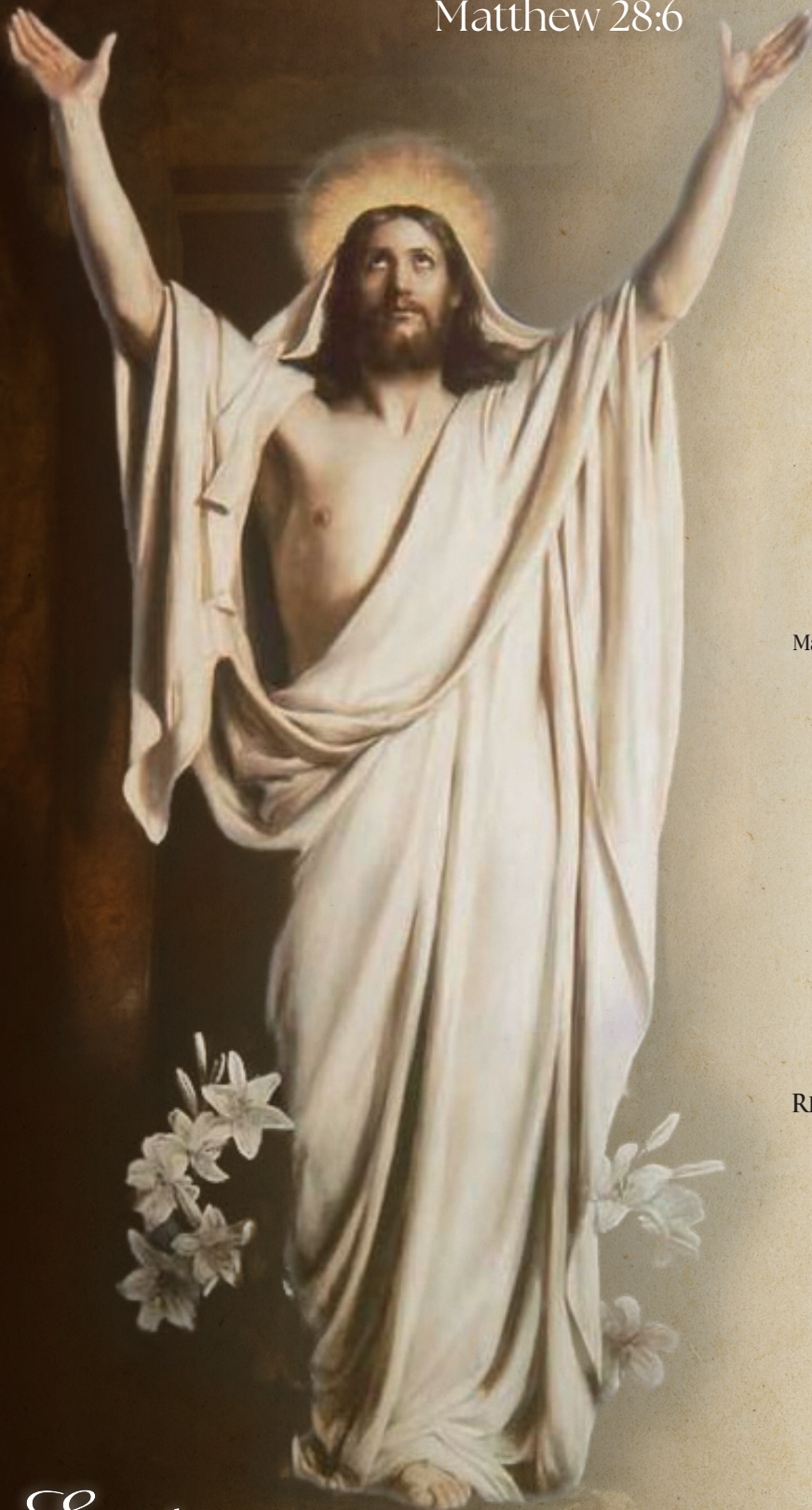

FROM THE PRIEST

This weekend, we celebrate the 3rd Sunday of the Easter season. What a beautiful time in the Church calendar as we celebrate Easter this springtime! The flowers and trees are blooming; gardening and planting have begun; temperatures are getting warmer as spring has officially sprung. During these next two months, we prepare for First Holy Communions, welcoming the Bishop at Confirmations, Graduations from school and Ordinations to the priesthood. Be assured of my prayers during this grace-filled time!

During the Easter season, there is a focus in the Book of The Acts of the Apostles in the first readings. The emphasis is often on what actions and challenges Jesus' disciples faced after the Resurrection. This served as a critically important time in the early Church, which lead to Pentecost, the birth of Holy Mother Church and the gift of the Holy Spirit (appearing as tongues of fire) over the Apostles in the Upper Room.

The Gospel of Luke and the Acts of the Apostles is known to be written by the same human author. I recommend taking time to read and reflect on God's word in these books, with a special emphasis on The Acts of the Apostles!

The Gospel today is from Luke and is known as "the Road to Emmaus." While there are so many beautiful gifts for us in this story, I would like to point out three things that stand out. First, the Apostles are crushed currently as they say to Jesus (not knowing it's Him yet) "Are you the only visitor in Jerusalem who does not know the things that have happened there in these days?"

Second, as the Apostles were walking and talking with the Lord but did not recognize Him yet, scripture says, "their hearts were burning within us as He spoke to us." Thirdly, they recognized Jesus finally in "the breaking of the bread," which points to the many times Jesus broke bread and gave it to the Apostles and God's people throughout His three-year public ministry, most especially at the Last Supper. Do you recognize Jesus in the breaking of bread and receiving the Eucharist?

A word of appreciation to the entire parish for actively participating in the Triduum; we had an incredible number of people attending. The Hispanic parishioners put on a powerful living Stations of the Cross on Good Friday and the weather cooperated!

I would also like to give a word of thanks to St. Mary's staff for all the hard work that needed to be accomplished, and most especially for St. Mary's choir for helping make the liturgies so beautiful.

St. Mary, Mother of God, pray for us!

DEL SACERDOTE

Este fin de semana celebramos el tercer domingo del tiempo pascual. ¡Qué hermoso momento en el calendario litúrgico de la Iglesia, al celebrar la Pascua en esta primavera! Las flores y los árboles están en flor; han comenzado las labores de jardinería y siembra; y las temperaturas se vuelven más cálidas, pues la primavera ha llegado oficialmente. Durante estos próximos dos meses, nos preparamos para las Primeras Comuniones, para recibir al Obispo en las Confirmaciones, para las graduaciones escolares y para las ordenaciones sacerdotales. ¡Tengan la certeza de mis oraciones durante este tiempo colmado de gracia!

Durante el tiempo pascual, las primeras lecturas se centran en el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles. A menudo, el énfasis recae en las acciones y los desafíos que enfrentaron los discípulos de Jesús tras la Resurrección. Este fue un periodo de vital importancia en la Iglesia primitiva, el cual condujo a Pentecostés: el nacimiento de la Santa Madre Iglesia y el don del Espíritu Santo (manifestado en forma de lenguas de fuego) sobre los Apóstoles en el Cenáculo.

Se sabe que el Evangelio de Lucas y los Hechos de los Apóstoles fueron escritos por el mismo autor humano. ¡Recomiendo dedicar tiempo a leer y reflexionar sobre la Palabra de Dios en estos libros, poniendo un énfasis especial en los Hechos de los Apóstoles!

El Evangelio de hoy proviene de Lucas y se conoce como "el camino a Emaús". Si bien hay tantos dones hermosos para nosotros en esta historia, me gustaría señalar tres aspectos que destacan. En primer lugar, los apóstoles se encuentran sumidos en la desolación en ese momento, tal como le dicen a Jesús (sin saber aún que es Él): "¿Eres tú el único forastero en Jerusalén que desconoce lo que ha sucedido allí en estos días?"

En segundo lugar, mientras los Apóstoles caminaban y conversaban con el Señor —a quien aún no reconocían—, la Escritura dice: "¿Acaso no ardía nuestro corazón dentro de nosotros mientras nos hablaba?". En tercer lugar, reconocieron finalmente a Jesús en "la fracción del pan", lo cual remite a las muchas ocasiones en que Jesús partió el pan y lo entregó a los Apóstoles y al pueblo de Dios a lo largo de sus tres años de ministerio público, muy especialmente en la Última Cena. ¿Reconoces tú a Jesús en la fracción del pan y al recibir la Eucaristía?

Una palabra de agradecimiento a toda la parroquia por participar activamente en el Triduo; tuvimos una asistencia de personas verdaderamente extraordinaria. Los feligreses hispanos presentaron un conmovedor Vía Crucis viviente el Viernes Santo, ¡y el clima nos acompañó!

También quisiera expresar mi gratitud al personal de St. Mary por todo el arduo trabajo realizado y, muy especialmente, al coro de St. Mary por contribuir a hacer que las liturgias fueran tan hermosas.

We are collecting home-baked cookies for the Kairos Ministry retreat at London Correctional. These cookies are a vital part of the ministry, helping inmates experience Christ's love in a tangible way.

To meet the ministry's needs and account for potential breakage, our church family is aiming for a total of **110 dozen**.

- **Collection Date:** Sunday, April 26th (**One Day Only!**)
- **Drop-off Location:** Designated boxes in the **Gathering Space**.

Important Baking & Packaging Guidelines

To comply with correctional facility security and safety protocols, please follow these instructions exactly:

THE COOKIES:

- **VARIETY:** Please bake **Chocolate Chip Cookies** *only* for this collection.
- **PREPARATION:** Home-made is preferred, but cookies baked by you from **mixes** or **pre-mixed dough (tubes/tubs)** are accepted. (**No store-bought, pre-baked cookies**).
- **SIZE:** Aim for **2-1/2" in diameter** (no larger than 3").
- **COOLING:** Cookies **MUST be completely cooled** before bagging to prevent them from sticking together.
- **STRICT NO-NOS:** No icing, no powdered sugar, and **absolutely no nuts or peanut butter**.

THE PACKAGING:

- **BAGS:** Use clear zip-top bags.
- **QUANTITY:** Place exactly **one dozen (12)** cookies in each bag.
- **RESTRICTIONS:** Do **not** include twist ties, aluminum foil, paper plates, or handwritten notes inside the bags.

A Prayerful Batch: As you bake, we invite you to pray for the inmates at London Correctional and the volunteers who will be sharing the Gospel with them.

- **Lugar de entrega:** Cajas designadas en el Área de Convivencia (Gathering Space).

Pautas importantes para la preparación y el empaquetado

Para cumplir con los protocolos de seguridad y protección del centro correccional, por favor siga estas instrucciones al pie de la letra:

LAS GALLETAS:

- **VARIEDAD:** Por favor, horneen únicamente galletas con chips de chocolate para esta recolección.
- **PREPARACIÓN:** Se prefieren las galletas hechas totalmente desde cero (caseras), pero se aceptan las horneadas por usted a partir de mezclas preparadas o masa premezclada (en tubos o recipientes). (No se aceptan galletas prehorneadas compradas en tiendas).
- **TAMAÑO:** Procure que tengan 2-1/2 pulgadas de diámetro (no más de 3 pulgadas).
- **ENFRIAMIENTO:** Las galletas DEBEN estar completamente frías antes de embolsarlas para evitar que se peguen entre sí.
- **PROHIBICIONES ESTRUCTAS:** No deben llevar glaseado, azúcar glas (azúcar en polvo) y, bajo ninguna circunstancia, frutos secos ni mantequilla de maní (cacahuete).

EL EMPAQUETADO:

- **BOLSAS:** Utilice bolsas transparentes con cierre hermético (tipo ziploc).
- **CANTIDAD:** Coloque exactamente **una docena (12)** de galletas en cada bolsa.
- **RESTRICCIONES:** No incluya alambres para cerrar bolsas, papel de aluminio, platos de papel ni notas escritas a mano dentro de las bolsas.
