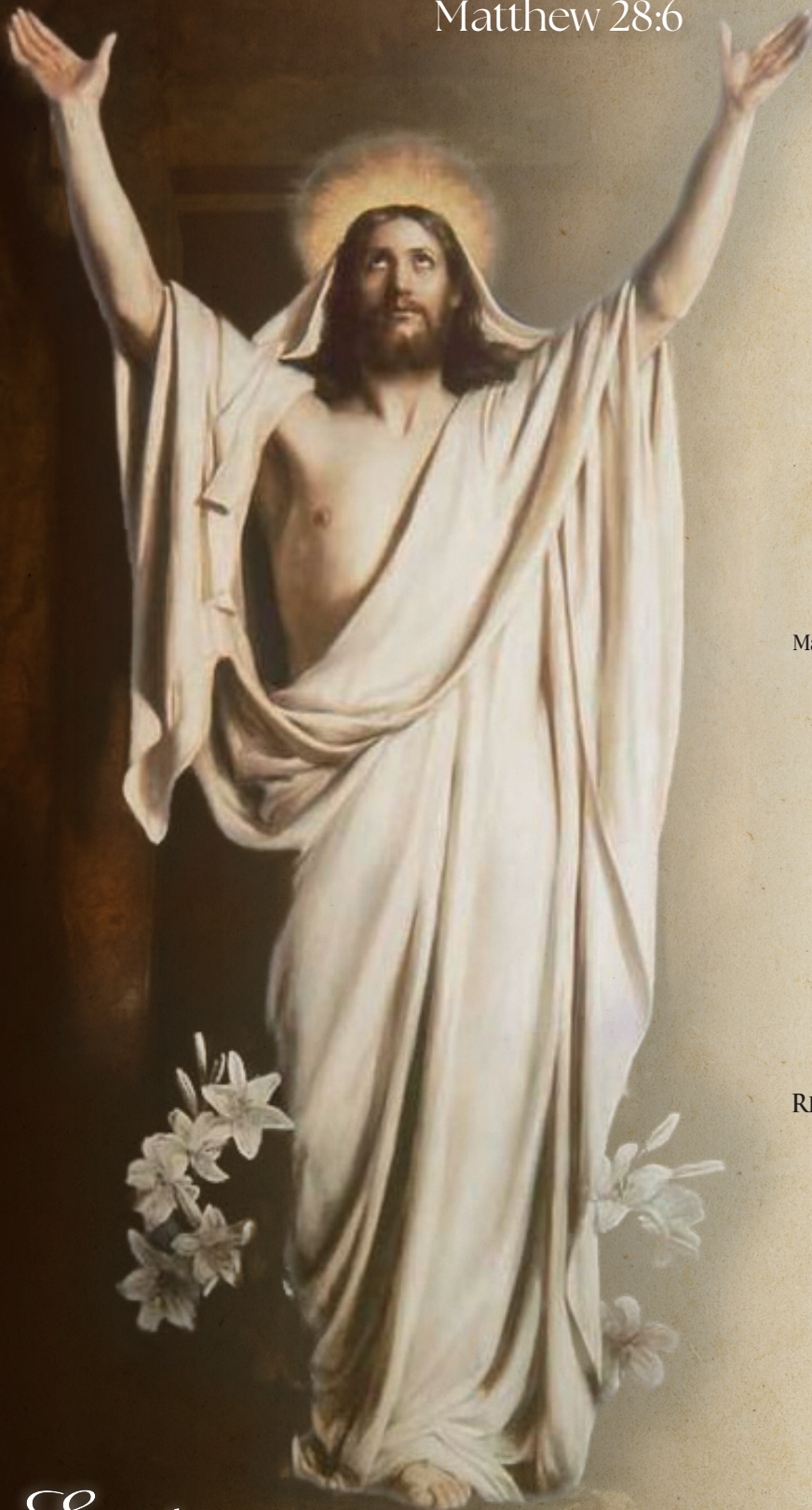

FROM THE PRIEST

We continue the celebration on this 4th Sunday of Easter remembering God's plan and gift for our salvation in Jesus Christ's Resurrection.

This week's Gospel continues in Chapter 10 of the Gospel of John. The imagery used to depict Jesus as the gatekeeper and shepherd of the sheep. This theme of shepherd is familiar to us. Jesus says the sheep know His voice and that He calls us by our names and leads us.

In 2014, I took a pilgrimage to Spain. I walked the El Camino de Santiago de Compostela. It was a 500-mile journey which I completed by the grace of God in 28 days. During this walk, I went everywhere, through major cities, small towns and rural areas. One day, I was on a path and encountered a shepherd with about 100 sheep blocking the path I was attempting to journey on. Once the shepherd saw me, he yelled out some commands to the sheep in Spanish and suddenly the path opened up so that I could cross on it. In the moment, I did not think much about. As time has passed and I have been able to reflect on the pilgrimage, I have realized the power of a shepherd's voice and how his sheep knows his voice, listen to his commands, and that the shepherd knows his sheep.

This experience provided a deepened meaning of who a shepherd is and what a shepherd does. A shepherd leads, guides and protects his sheep. Jesus then reminds us, "I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved and will come in and go out and find pasture." That is who Jesus is for us!

Holy Mother Church refers to Bishops as shepherds of their diocese. We refer to Bishop Fernandes as the Shepherd of the diocese of Columbus. We pray at every Mass for the Pope and our Bishop, that they may continue to follow the example and lead us to Christ the Good shepherd on our pilgrimage of life.

Jesus does not mince words here, He says "I am the gate", (not you or me or any other god or religion). Do you believe this? Do you hear the shepherd's voice calling you in your life? He knows each of us personally by our names and opens wide the gate for us to enter, aided by His grace and mercy! Happy Easter season.

DEL SACERDOTE

Continuamos la celebración en este cuarto Domingo de Pascua, recordando el plan y el don de Dios para nuestra salvación en la resurrección de Jesucristo.

El Evangelio de esta semana continúa en el capítulo 10 del Evangelio de San Juan. Se utiliza una imagería para representar a Jesús como el portero y el pastor de las ovejas. Este tema del pastor nos resulta familiar. Jesús dice que las ovejas conocen su voz, que Él nos llama por nuestro nombre y que nos guía.

En 2014, realicé una peregrinación a España. Recorrí el Camino de Santiago de Compostela. Fue un viaje de 500 millas que, por la gracia de Dios, completé en 28 días. Durante esta caminata, pasé por todo tipo de lugares: grandes ciudades, pueblos pequeños y zonas rurales. Un día, mientras caminaba por un sendero, me encontré con un pastor y un rebaño de unas 100 ovejas que bloqueaban el camino que yo intentaba seguir. En cuanto el pastor me vio, gritó algunas órdenes a las ovejas en español y, de repente, el camino se abrió para permitirme el paso. En aquel momento no le di mucha importancia. Sin embargo, con el paso del tiempo —y tras haber podido reflexionar sobre aquella peregrinación— he comprendido el poder de la voz de un pastor: cómo sus ovejas la reconocen, cómo obedecen sus órdenes y cómo el pastor conoce a sus ovejas.

Esta experiencia me permitió profundizar en el significado de lo que es un pastor y de lo que hace. Un pastor guía, orienta y protege a sus ovejas. Jesús nos recuerda entonces: "Yo soy la puerta. Quien entre por mí se salvará; podrá entrar y salir, y encontrará pastos". ¡Eso es lo que Jesús es para nosotros!

La Santa Madre Iglesia se refiere a los obispos como los pastores de sus respectivas diócesis. Nosotros nos referimos al obispo Fernandes como el Pastor de la Diócesis de Columbus. En cada Misa, rezamos por el Papa y por nuestro obispo, para que sigan el ejemplo de Cristo y nos conduzcan hacia Él —el Buen Pastor— a lo largo de nuestra peregrinación por la vida.

Jesús no se anda con rodeos en este pasaje; afirma: "Yo soy la puerta" (y no tú, ni yo, ni ningún otro dios o religión). ¿Crees tú en esto? ¿Escuchas la voz del Pastor que te llama en tu propia vida? Él nos conoce personalmente a cada uno por nuestro nombre y nos abre de par en par la puerta para que entremos, asistidos por su gracia y misericordia. ¡Feliz tiempo de Pascua!



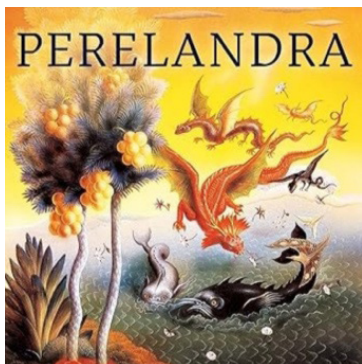
