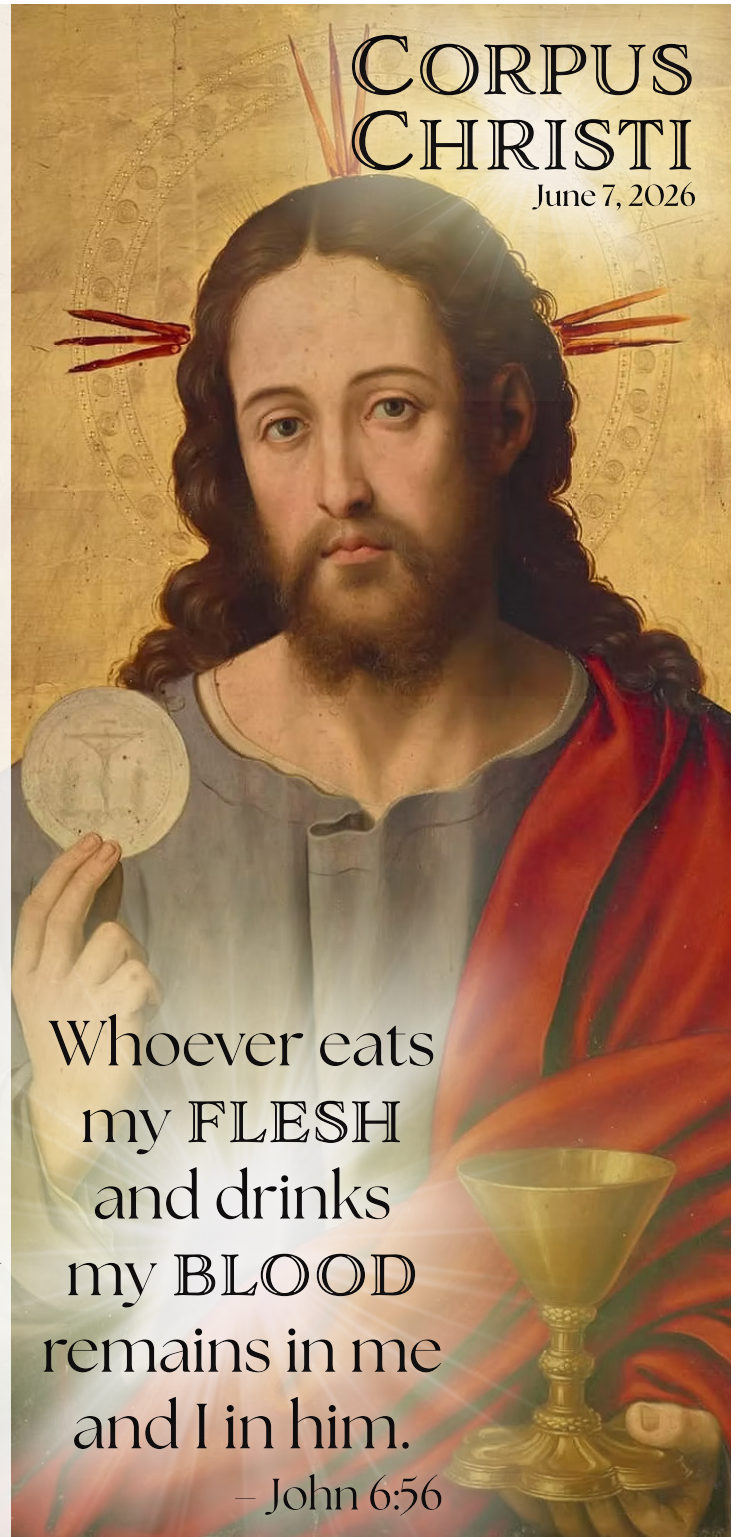

## FROM THE PRIEST

This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of (Corpus Christi) the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Think about that for a moment...let this reality sink in... "Faith in God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Trinity), is not a distant and unattainable experience. Instead, it is as near since it is perennially "broken" for us: *This is my Body... This is my blood.*"

In 1207, a Belgian Augustinian nun, Giuliana di Cornillon, who had just turned fifteen, had a vision of a full moon with a dark spot sullyng it. Contemporary experts interpreted it thus: the full moon symbolized the Church, the dark spot was the absence of a specific feast in honour of the Body of the Eucharistic Jesus. The following year, the same religious had an even clearer vision, but had to fight hard to get the feast instituted. She succeeded only at the diocesan level, when Robert de Thourette became bishop of Liège in 1247. In 1261, the former archdeacon of Liège, Jacques Pantelón, became Pope Urban IV. In 1264, impressed by a Eucharistic miracle that had taken place in Bolsena, near Orvieto in Italy where he was residing, he promulgated the bull *Transiturus* through which he instituted a new solemnity to be celebrated the Thursday after the Octave of Pentecost in honour of the Blessed Sacrament. Thomas Aquinas was given the task of composing the liturgical office. The last strophe of the very famous hymn he wrote, *Sacris Solemniis*, which begins with the words *Panis angelicus* (Bread of angels), has often been set to different musical scores, apart from the rest of the hymn. Since Pope Urban IV died two months after having instituted the feast, the bull was never implemented, but Pope Clement V, the first Avignon Pope (1312), confirmed it later.

The now traditional procession of Corpus Christi was introduced by Pope John XXII in 1316. During his pastoral visit to Orvieto, Saint John Paul II said: *"Even though the construction of this cathedral was not directly connected with the Solemnity of 'Corpus Christi', instituted by Pope Urban IV with the bull Transiturus, in 1264, nor with the miracle that took place in Bolsena the previous year, there is no doubt that the Eucharistic miracle is powerfully evidenced here due to the corporal of Bolsena for which the chapel was specifically built and which it now jealously guards. Since then, the city of Orvieto became known throughout the world due to that miraculous sign that reminds all of us of the merciful love of God who becomes the food and drink of salvation for humanity on its early pilgrimage. Because of the cult rendered to such a great mystery, your city preserves and nourishes the inextinguishable flame"* (17 June 1990)." <https://www.vaticannews.va/en/liturgical-holidays/solemnity-of-the-most-holy-body-and-blood-of-christ--corpus-chri.html>

**What is the Miracle of Orvieto?**

The Miracle of Orvieto (also known as the Miracle of Bolsena) is a recognized Eucharistic miracle that occurred in 1263. When a doubting priest consecrated the Host, it bled onto the altar cloth (corporal). This relic is preserved in the Duomo di Orvieto, and its discovery directly inspired Pope Urban IV to establish the global Feast of Corpus Christi.

- A Bohemian priest – Peter of Prague – had doubts about transubstantiation, i.e., that during consecration, the Communion bread became the Body of Christ. In 1263, Peter stopped in Bolsena on his pilgrimage to Rome. He was celebrating Mass in the church of Santa Cristina when drops of blood started falling from the Communion bread he was holding, staining the corporal, i.e., the altar linen used during the Mass. When Pope Urban IV learned about this miracle, he had the Sacred Altar Linen moved to Orvieto, where he was at the time and where he established the Feast of Corpus Christi by the *Transiturus* bull in 1264.
- Orvieto commemorates the Miracle of Bolsena and the Feast of Corpus Christi every year with the procession of the Blessed Sacrament and the Sacred Corporal. This procession is accompanied by a parade in medieval costumes, where the magistracies of the medieval communes and the coat of arms of the local noble families are represented.

I had the opportunity in 2014 to travel with my classmates in seminary to Orvieto and made a pilgrimage to visit the Church where this miracle took place, The Chapel of the Corporal. It was a transformational grace-filled experience.

We will have a Eucharistic procession after the 11:00 a.m. Mass, before the 12:30 p.m. Spanish Mass. All are invited to participate.

I want to thank you for your prayers, cards and gifts at my 10-year anniversary celebration after 11:00 a.m. Mass last Sunday. I am extremely grateful to all of you and am truly blessed. Happy Feast Day.

## DEL SACERDOTE

*Este domingo celebramos la Solemnidad del (Corpus Christi) Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Reflexionen sobre ello por un momento... dejen que esta realidad cale hondo... "La fe en Dios —Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo (la Trinidad)— no es una experiencia distante e inalcanzable. Por el contrario, es tan cercana, puesto que es perennemente "partida" para nosotros: "Este es mi Cuerpo... Esta es mi Sangre". En 1207, una monja agustina belga, Juliana de Cornillon —quien acababa de cumplir quince años— tuvo una visión de una luna llena con una mancha oscura que la empañaba. Los expertos de la época la interpretaron de este modo: la luna llena simbolizaba a la Iglesia, y la mancha oscura representaba la ausencia de una fiesta específica en honor al Cuerpo de Jesús Eucarístico. Al año siguiente, la misma religiosa tuvo una visión aún más clara, pero tuvo que luchar arduamente para lograr que se instituyera la festividad. Solo lo consiguió a nivel diocesano, cuando Robert de Thourette se convirtió en obispo de Lieja en 1247. En 1261, el antiguo arcediano de Lieja, Jacques Pantelón, se convirtió en el papa Urbano IV. En 1264, impresionado por un milagro eucarístico que había tenido lugar en Bolsena —cerca de Orvieto, en Italia, donde él residía—, promulgó la bula \*Transiturus\*, mediante la cual instituyó una nueva solemnidad que debía celebrarse el jueves siguiente a la Octava de Pentecostés, en honor al Santísimo Sacramento. A Santo Tomás de Aquino se le encomendó la tarea de componer el oficio litúrgico. La última estrofa del muy célebre himno que él escribió, \*Sacris Solemniis\* —la cual comienza con las palabras \*Panis angelicus\* (Pan de los ángeles)— ha sido musicalizada a menudo en diversas partituras, de manera independiente del resto del himno. Dado que el papa Urbano IV falleció dos meses después de haber instituido la festividad, la bula nunca llegó a implementarse; sin embargo, el papa Clemente V —el primer papa de Aviñón— la confirmó posteriormente en 1312. La ya tradicional procesión del Corpus Christi fue instituida por el Papa Juan XXII en 1316. Durante su visita pastoral a Orvieto, San Juan Pablo II afirmó: «Aunque la construcción de esta catedral no estuvo directamente vinculada con la Solemnidad del "Corpus Christi" —instituida por el Papa Urbano IV mediante la bula \*Transiturus\* en 1264—, ni tampoco con el milagro acaecido en Bolsena el año anterior, no cabe duda de que el milagro eucarístico halla aquí un testimonio elocuente gracias al corporal de Bolsena, para el cual fue erigida específicamente esta capilla y que ella custodia hoy con celo. Desde entonces, la ciudad de Orvieto ha adquirido renombre mundial gracias a ese signo milagroso que nos recuerda a todos el amor misericordioso de Dios, quien se convierte en alimento y bebida de salvación para la humanidad en su peregrinaje terrenal. En virtud del culto tributado a tan excelso misterio, vuestra ciudad preserva y alimenta una llama inextinguible (17 de junio de 1990). <https://www.vaticannews.va/en/liturgical-holidays/solemnity-of-the-most-holy-body-and-blood-of-christ--corpus-chri.html>*

**¿Qué es el Milagro de Orvieto?**

El Milagro de Orvieto (también conocido como el Milagro de Bolsena) es un milagro eucarístico reconocido que ocurrió en 1263. Cuando un sacerdote que tenía dudas consagró la Hostia, esta sangró sobre el lienzo del altar (el corporal). Esta reliquia se conserva en el Duomo de Orvieto, y su descubrimiento inspiró directamente al Papa Urbano IV a establecer la festividad universal del Corpus Christi.

- Un sacerdote bohemio —Pedro de Praga— tenía dudas sobre la transustanciación; es decir, sobre el hecho de que, durante la consagración, el pan de la comunión se convirtiera en el Cuerpo de Cristo. En 1263, Pedro hizo una parada en Bolsena durante su peregrinación a Roma. Se encontraba celebrando la Misa en la iglesia de Santa Cristina cuando comenzaron a caer gotas de sangre del pan de la comunión que sostenía, manchando el corporal —es decir, el lienzo del altar que se utiliza durante la Misa—. Cuando el Papa Urbano IV se enteró de este milagro, ordenó trasladar el Sagrado Lienzo del Altar a Orvieto —lugar donde él se encontraba en aquel momento— y allí estableció la festividad del Corpus Christi mediante la bula \*Transiturus\* en 1264.
- Orvieto conmemora el Milagro de Bolsena y la festividad del Corpus Christi cada año con una procesión del Santísimo Sacramento y del Sagrado Corporal. Esta procesión va acompañada de un desfile con trajes medievales, en el que se representan las magistraturas de las comunas medievales y los escudos de armas de las familias nobles locales.

Tuve la oportunidad, en el año 2014, de viajar con mis compañeros de seminario a Orvieto y realizar una peregrinación para visitar la iglesia donde tuvo lugar este milagro: la Capilla del Corporal. Fue una experiencia transformadora y colmada de gracia.

Tendremos una procesión eucarística después de la Misa de las 11:00 a. m., y antes de la Misa en español de las 12:30 p. m. Todos están invitados a participar.

Deseo agradecerles sus oraciones, sus tarjetas y sus regalos con motivo de la celebración de mi décimo aniversario, la cual tuvo lugar el domingo pasado después de la Misa de las 11:00 a. m. Estoy sumamente agradecido con todos ustedes y me siento verdaderamente bendecido. ¡Feliz día de la fiesta ¡María, Madre de Dios, ruega por nosotros! – P. Lynch


