FROM THE PRIEST

This Sunday, we celebrate the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the first reading today in 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16a, we are reminded of the true statement, “with God all things are possible.” Regardless of where our faith is, God can do things beyond human limitations.

We never get the name of the husband and wife who have struggled mightily with fertility, but we do hear of their hospitality in providing food and shelter for the prophet as he journeys. For their hospitality the prophet Elisha makes a promise, in answer to their hopes and prayers. Elisha promised, “This time next year you will be cradling a baby son.” Which did come true.

Our faith and trust in God can ebb and flow. Never underestimate the gift of faith. Elisha makes the promise to the couple. Perhaps they received this news with humility and gratitude, or it was a cause of sadness, guilt or shame, as they had been trying and were unsuccessful for so long.

The important aspect of faith to note is that every single promise God makes, either directly or through His prophets, every single promise is fulfilled and true. We get to see that in action in the lives of the husband and wife. God provides and restores hope.

I pray every day for the parish, for married couples or those discerning marriage. If any married couple is trying to conceive and needs prayers, please let me know, so I can pray for you specifically. I also pray for all couples who have experienced the loss of a baby by miscarriage or any other way. Scripture tells us that they are with the Lord, where we all hope to be, reunited in love in Heaven.

In the Gospel today, Jesus is addressing His Apostles. He provides instructive actions and follows up with promises for doing them. These actions helped the Apostles and us today, to surrender our pride and ego and grow in Christ through His grace and being humble. Humility is the key that unlocks our willingness. Every action Jesus asks us to follow detaches us from this temporary world and attaches us more to Christ and the eternal Kingdom to come.

If you are travelling this upcoming 4th of July weekend, be safe! To everyone else, I look forward to celebrating Mass and the United States of America's 250th birthday with you all.

Mary, Mother of God, pray for us!

DEL SACERDOTE

Este domingo celebramos el 13.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. En la primera lectura de hoy, tomada del segundo libro de los Reyes (4, 8-11, 14-16a), se nos recuerda una gran verdad: “para Dios todo es posible”. Independientemente del estado de nuestra fe, Dios puede realizar obras que trascienden las limitaciones humanas.

Nunca llegamos a conocer los nombres del matrimonio que tanto había luchado por tener hijos, pero sí sabemos de su hospitalidad al ofrecer alimento y refugio al profeta durante sus viajes. En recompensa por esa hospitalidad, y respondiendo a sus esperanzas y oraciones, el profeta Eliseo les hace una promesa: “El año que viene, por estas fechas, estarás acunando a un hijo varón”. Lo cual se cumplió.

Nuestra fe y confianza en Dios pueden tener altibajos. Nunca subestimemos el don de la fe. Eliseo hace la promesa a la pareja. Quizás recibieron esta noticia con humildad y gratitud, o tal vez les causó tristeza, culpa o vergüenza, dado que llevaban mucho tiempo intentándolo sin éxito.

El aspecto importante de la fe que debemos notar es que cada promesa que Dios hace —ya sea directamente o a través de sus profetas— se cumple y es verdadera. Vemos esto en acción en la vida de este matrimonio: Dios provee y restaura la esperanza.

Rezo todos los días por la parroquia, por los matrimonios y por aquellos que están discerniendo el matrimonio. Si alguna pareja está intentando concebir y necesita oraciones, por favor hágamelo saber para poder rezar específicamente por ustedes. También rezo por todas las parejas que han sufrido la pérdida de un bebé, ya sea por aborto espontáneo o de cualquier otra forma. Las Escrituras nos dicen que ellos están con el Señor —donde todos esperamos estar—, reunidos en el amor en el Cielo.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús se dirige a sus Apóstoles. Propone acciones instructivas y las acompaña de promesas para quienes las llevan a cabo. Estas acciones ayudaron a los Apóstoles —y nos ayudan hoy a nosotros— a dejar de lado el orgullo y el ego, y a crecer en Cristo mediante su gracia y la humildad. La humildad es la llave que abre nuestra disposición. Cada acción que Jesús nos pide realizar nos despega de este mundo pasajero y nos une más a Cristo y al Reino eterno venidero.

Si van a viajar durante el próximo fin de semana del 4 de julio, ¡cuídense mucho! A todos los demás, espero verlos para celebrar la Misa y el 250.º aniversario de los Estados Unidos de América.

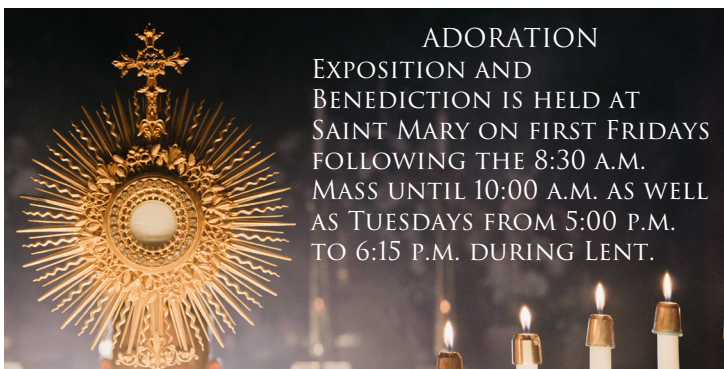

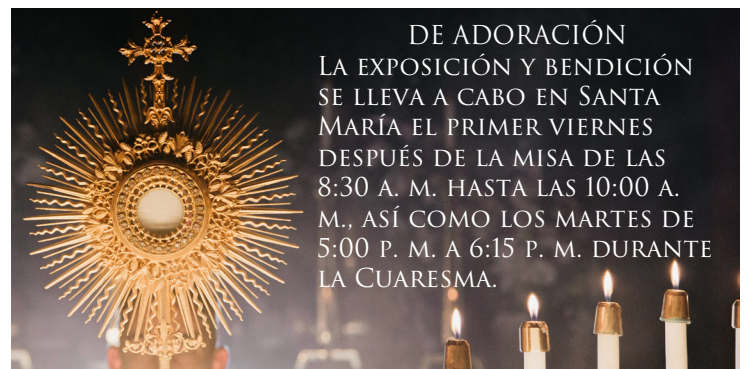

ALL COLUMBUS CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL REUNION LUNCH (PRE-1977 CLASSES)

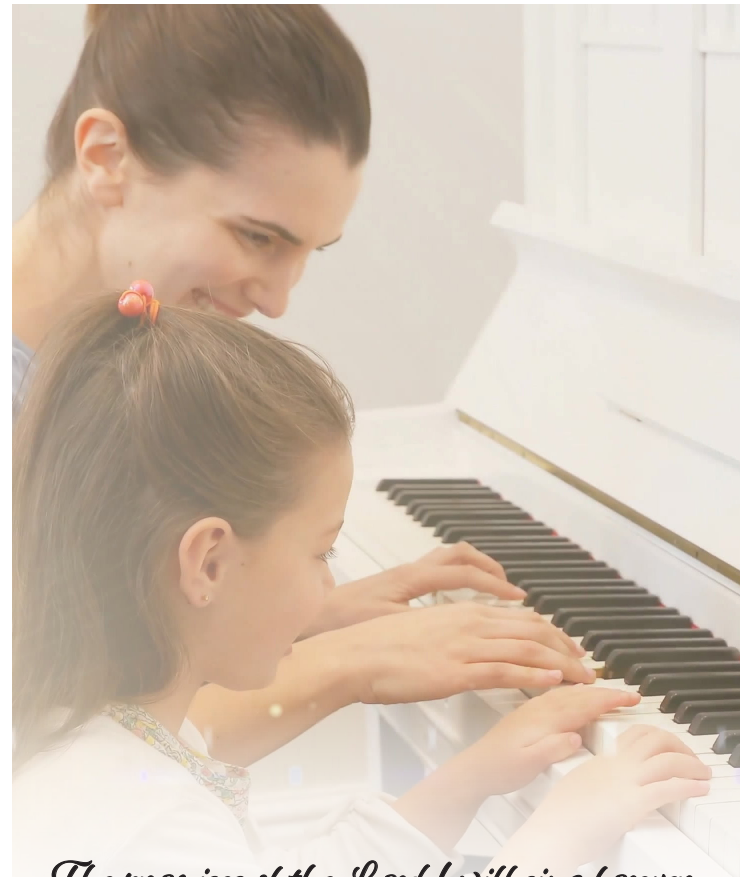
