FROM THE PRIEST

This Sunday, we celebrate the 15th Sunday in Ordinary time. Today's readings are about the transforming power of the word of God when read, preached, and lived. They also warn us not to be disappointed at the absence of immediate results. We must take a positive and optimistic view of our missionary efforts, as we keep on bearing witness to Christ's Gospel. The parable of the Sower in today's Gospel challenges us to listen intently to God's Word, to be open to it, and to allow our lives to be shaped by its power. The parable reminds us that man's reception of God's Word is determined by the condition of his heart.

This coming Tuesday, we welcome Fr. Tomas. We will celebrate all Masses next weekend together and will have refreshments for a "meet and greet" after the Masses in Heritage Hall. Please stop by after Mass and introduce yourself to Padre Tomas.

In addition to having Fr. Tomas on staff, we will now add a Monday morning daily Mass to the parish schedule at 8:30 a.m.

The construction continues in both the school and parish Atrium. All main areas for school children will be open at the start of the school year; however, some work in the basement may still be finishing up in late August into September. Thank you for your prayers and patience.

Gina Stull has asked for donations to St. Mary's school for gently used musical instruments, as all of the instruments were stored in the basement and got contaminated and destroyed from the flood in late May.

In lieu of the parish festival being cancelled due to the ongoing construction, we will work on other parish projects that need attention. This summer, we will be landscaping and resurfacing the Church parking lot, repainting the parking lines and fixing some areas that needed repair. Please note that the handicap parking will be moved from in front of the Specht Center to the back of the Church by the Handicap access ramp, providing better accessibility to the Church.

Finally, many of you asked for a copy of the prayer I shared last week in my homily. I found it on a social media thread. When we approach prayer striving to be meek and humble, we can offer prayers like this to God, but when we ask, we must prepare to accept God's answer. If He says "no" to our prayer request, then we have to accept the answer, understanding that God's answer is always the right one meant to draw us closer to Him and to do His will.

"I asked God to take my habit away. God said no, it is not for me to take away but for you to give it up. I asked God to grant me patience. God said no, patience is a byproduct of tribulations, it isn't granted it is earned. I asked God to give me happiness. God said no, I gave you blessings, happiness is up to you. I asked God to spare me pain. God said no, suffering draws you apart from worldly cares and brings you closer to me. I asked God to make my spirit grow. God said no, you must grow on your own, but I will prune you and make you fruitful. I asked God for all things that I might enjoy in life. God said no, I will give you life so that you may enjoy all things; then I asked God to help me love others as much as He loves me, God said, finally you get the idea."

Este domingo celebramos el 15.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. Las lecturas de hoy tratan sobre el poder transformador de la Palabra de Dios cuando se lee, se predica y se vive. También nos advierten que no debemos desanimarnos ante la ausencia de resultados inmediatos. Debemos mantener una visión positiva y optimista de nuestros esfuerzos misioneros mientras seguimos dando testimonio del Evangelio de Cristo. La parábola del Sembrador, en el Evangelio de hoy, nos desafía a escuchar con atención la Palabra de Dios, a estar abiertos a ella y a permitir que nuestras vidas sean moldeadas por su poder. La parábola nos recuerda que la acogida de la Palabra de Dios por parte del ser humano depende del estado de su corazón. El próximo martes damos la bienvenida al Padre Tomás. Celebraremos todas las misas juntos el próximo fin de semana y ofreceremos un refrigerio para saludarle y conocerle en el salón de la iglesia después de las misas. Por favor, acérquese después de misa para presentarse ante el Padre Tomás.

Además de contar con el Padre Tomás en el equipo parroquial, añadiremos una misa diaria los lunes por la mañana a las 8:30 a. m. al horario de la parroquia.

Continúan las obras de construcción tanto en la escuela como en el atrio de la parroquia. Todas las áreas principales para los alumnos estarán habilitadas al inicio del año escolar; sin embargo, es posible que algunos trabajos en el sótano se prolonguen hasta finales de agosto o principios de septiembre. Gracias por sus oraciones y paciencia.

Gina Stull ha solicitado donaciones de instrumentos musicales en buen estado para la escuela St. Mary's, ya que todos los instrumentos que estaban almacenados en el sótano quedaron contaminados y destruidos debido a la inundación de finales de mayo.

*Dado que el festival parroquial ha sido cancelado debido a las obras en curso, nos dedicaremos a otros proyectos parroquiales que requieren atención. Este verano trabajaremos en el paisajismo y la renovación de la superficie del estacionamiento de la iglesia, repintaremos las líneas de aparcamiento y repararemos algunas zonas que lo necesitaban. Tenga en cuenta que las plazas de aparcamiento para personas con discapacidad se trasladarán de la parte delantera del *Specht Center* a la parte trasera de la iglesia, junto a la rampa de acceso para discapacitados, para facilitar así el acceso al templo. Por último, muchos de ustedes han pedido una copia de la oración que compartí la semana pasada en mi homilía. La encontré en una publicación de redes sociales. Cuando nos acercamos a la oración esforzándonos por ser mansos y humildes, podemos dirigir a Dios peticiones como esta; sin embargo, al pedir, debemos estar preparados para aceptar la respuesta divina. Si Él responde "no" a nuestra petición, debemos aceptar dicha respuesta, comprendiendo que lo que Dios decide es siempre lo correcto y busca acercarnos más a Él y ayudarnos a cumplir su voluntad.*

"Le pedí a Dios que me quitara un hábito. Dios respondió que no: no me corresponde a Mí quitártelo, sino a ti dejarlo. Le pedí a Dios que me concediera paciencia. Dios dijo que no: la paciencia es fruto de las tribulaciones; no se concede, se gana. Le pedí a Dios que me diera felicidad. Dios dijo que no: te di bendiciones; la felicidad depende de ti. Le pedí a Dios que me librara del dolor. Dios dijo que no: el sufrimiento te aparta de las preocupaciones mundanas y te acerca a mí. Le pedí a Dios que hiciera crecer mi espíritu. Dios dijo que no: debes crecer por ti mismo, pero yo te podaré y te haré dar fruto. Le pedí a Dios todas las cosas que pudiera disfrutar en la vida. Dios dijo que no: te daré la vida para que puedas disfrutar de todas las cosas. Entonces le pedí a Dios que me ayudara a amar a los demás tanto como Él me ama; Dios dijo: "Por fin has entendido la idea".

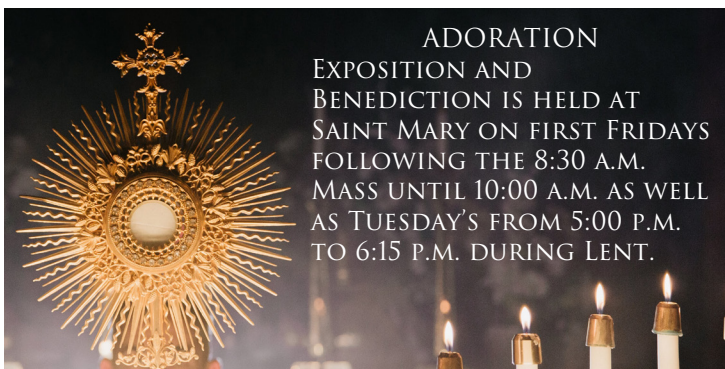

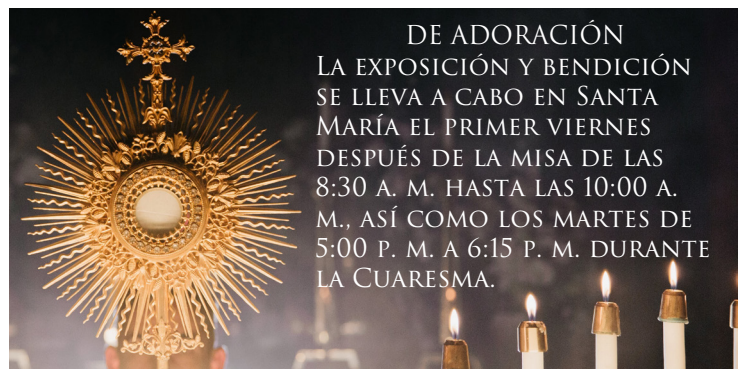

PARISH FESTIVAL UPDATE

Saint Mary, Mother of God Parish. As we were preparing to celebrate the end of a wonderful school year, a sewer collapse in Columbus unexpectedly impacted several buildings on our campus. Out of an abundance of caution, we quickly evacuated students and began summer break a week early to ensure everyone's safety. The extent of the damage has been significant. We lost all the contents in the basement of the main school, as well as our catechesis of the Good Shepherd Rooms in the Berkley Center.

Over this summer, workers have been diligently trying to repair these spaces and restore them in time for the start of the new school year. It was our hope that it might even be done before our festival in August. However, after a meeting with Gina Stull and the construction team last week, it was determined that the repairs will likely extend to the end of August. As a result, the parish festival – originally hoped to take place this year– will be postponed, until next year.

Alternatives for a parish gathering are being considered, and further updates will be announced if plans develop. I ask for your support and prayers for the restoration process and the community during this period.

Through the intercession of St. Joseph the carpenter, may God bless the workers, school and parish! – Fr. Lynch

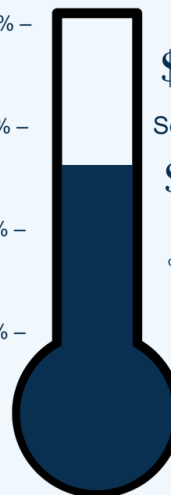

ACTUALIZACIÓN SOBRE EL FESTIVAL PARROQUIAL

Parroquia de Santa María, Madre de Dios. Mientras nos preparábamos para celebrar el final de un maravilloso año escolar, el colapso de una tubería de alcantarillado en Columbus afectó inesperadamente varios edificios de nuestras instalaciones. Por precaución, evacuamos rápidamente a los alumnos y adelantamos una semana el inicio de las vacaciones de verano para garantizar la seguridad de todos. Los daños han sido considerables. Perdimos todo el contenido del sótano del edificio principal de la escuela, así como las aulas del programa de catequesis "El Buen Pastor" en el Centro Berkley.

Durante el verano, los trabajadores se han esforzado diligentemente por reparar y restaurar estos espacios a tiempo para el inicio del nuevo año escolar. Esperábamos incluso que los trabajos estuvieran terminados antes de nuestro festival de agosto.

Sin embargo, tras una reunión celebrada la semana pasada con Gina Stull y el equipo de construcción, se determinó que es probable que las reparaciones se prolonguen hasta finales de agosto. En consecuencia, el festival parroquial —que originalmente esperábamos celebrar este año— se pospondrá hasta el próximo año.

Se están considerando alternativas para organizar un encuentro parroquial y se comunicarán más novedades si los planes llegan a concretarse. Les pido su apoyo y sus oraciones por el proceso de restauración y por la comunidad durante este tiempo.
